AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

1. That I, RICK VON ROHR, am an Investigator with the Pekin Police Department (PPD) and that I have been personally involved with the investigation of this offense and that I have received information from other officers involved in this investigation as well as from medical personnel who have treated the victim.
2. That on 6/21/06 at 5:44 a.m. rescue and ambulance personnel were dispatched to 221 Cooper, Pekin, Tazewell County, Illinois on a report of a 4 year old girl having convulsions. That upon arrival the medical personnel discovered the victim, Lexus Fuller, DOB: 9/21/01, unresponsive and having seizures. The child's father, Scott Fuller, told rescue personnel at the scene that his girlfriend and the child's mother, Kellie A. Waremburg, DOB: 8/22/73, had overdosed their child and was suicidal. That after the child was taken away by ambulance the Defendant re-entered the residence and locked the door to said residence. That police and rescue personnel made forced entry into the home and discovered the Defendant with self-inflicted cuts on her body.
3. That the child was transported to Pekin Memorial Hospital (PMH) along with her father where she was treated and was subsequently transferred to St. Francis Medical Center in Peoria where she is in critical condition after being diagnosed with a drug overdose as confirmed by hospital lab tests. That according to the medical personnel one of the drugs was an active ingredient in sleeping medication. That according to medical personnel the effect of the drug overdose on the victim was to cause her to have seizures, to loose consciousness, to have a dangerous lowering of body temperature and blood pressure, to suppress her breathing necessitating the insertion of a breathing tube, and to experience cardiac arrest from which she was resuscitated.
4. That the Defendant was transported to PMH where she told medical personnel in the presence of an officer that she tried to overdose her daughter. That on 6/21/06 I personally interviewed the Defendant several times in the PMH ER after she waived Miranda and that in these interviews she told me that she gave her daughter a mixture of liquid phenobarbital with 100 crushed sleeping pills. The Defendant stated that she wanted to kill herself due to personal issues, but that she decided to give the mixture to her daughter to get her "to go to sleep and not wake up". That the victim is physically handicapped in that she has cerebral palsy, blindness, mental retardation, is wheelchair-bound and had to be fed through a tube.

That the above information is true to the best of my knowledge, information and belief based upon said documentation and sources.
